

MINI BIKE RULES

ALL mini bikes MUST be registered, pass tech, and have a number. Registration will be at the registration booth located at the Volunteer Trailer.

Pre-Registration Online:

Everyone is REQUIRED to register ONLINE and prior to 9am on Saturday August 13, 2022.

Everyone is REQUIRED to sign the waiver IN PERSON prior to 9am on Saturday August 13, 2022.

Signed Waivers:

Waivers must be signed IN PERSON and witnessed by a Symco Volunteer that you are directly submitting it to.

Waivers are located in the Volunteer Trailer any time on:

- Thursday and Friday while open
- Saturday from 8am to 9am

******In order to race, you MUST register during these times and waivers must be signed. There will be NO exceptions.***

Rules and Expectations:

- There will be only one rider per bike IN A CLASS
- In bracket racing, your bike will only race in one class!
- You may race other bikes in a class at Grudge Racing after the drags end.
- You MUST be inspected at registration and you MUST pass inspection to race!!
- You MUST sign the liability waiver before you ride at Symco!
- If you are under 18 years old, you MUST have a parental consent form signed!
- 16-year-old riders must wear a helmet at all times on the Symco Grounds! There is no age limit or age classes.

***After all brackets have been finished, awards will be given out in all classes.

Additional Mini Bike Disclosure /Expectations on Symco Grounds:

Minibikes are not allowed to be ridden on the Symco Grounds, at all. Mini Bikes are racing during OUR designated race times, only. You will get one warning if you are caught riding. After that, the Waupaca County Sheriffs department will handle any and all issues, including citations for illegal riding on the grounds. Symco Grounds is defined as but not limited to the parking lot, camping areas, swap meet, and show grounds.
